### **Susan Blight**

*Untitled (Land and Life)*

Susan Blight honors the Anishinaabeg peoples of Canada and the United States with her poster, *Untitled (Land and Life)*. Blight depicts Nanaboozhoo, the half-human, half-spirit teacher, in the traditional Anishinaabeg pictograph technique. She articulates an interconnected landscape that includes land, sky, spirit, humans, and consciousness, referencing the inextricable link between land and life.

Susan Blight honra a los pueblos Anishinaabeg de Canadá y Estados Unidos con su cartel *Untitled (Land and Life)*. Blight representa a Nanaboozhoo, el maestro mitad humano, mitad espíritu, usando la técnica pictográfica tradicional Anishinaabeg. La artista crea un paisaje interconectado que incluye la tierra, el cielo, los espíritus, los seres humanos y la conciencia, haciendo referencia al vínculo inextricable entre la vida y la tierra.
